Intermediate-2 (3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •compare the culture of your own country and other countries and explain the differences. •write and speak about your experience in detail.
Intermediate to Advanced-1 (3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •comprehend written and spoken passages about culture and society, and mention your opinion on them. •concisely summarize what you would like to say and exchange information or opinions with others.
Intermediate to Advanced-2 (3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •understand the main points in newspapers and news, and mention your opinions on them. •Exchange information and opinions with those who have different views than you, using appropriate expressions.
Advanced-1 (3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •gather and use information on the topics of your interest from sources, like newspapers and the Internet. •communicate your opinions and feedback in appropriate expressions, considering situations and your relationship with the person(s) you are speaking to.
Advanced-2 (3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •read and listen to documentaries and comprehend them. Also, discuss the contents. •write persuasive essays in a good structure and give presentations

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
